- (c) (i) "Sacred and Profane Love"

Or

- (ii) Bernini's David
- d) (i) Carot's use of light

Or

- (ii) The painterly influence in Thompson's "The Seasons"
- (e) (i) The woman's downturned face in Vermeer's The Lacemaker

- (ii) The significance of broadsheets in Industry and Idleness.
- (f) (i) Lessing on time in relation to poetry and painting

 - (ii) Ruskin's notion of novelty in landscape.
- 2 (a) Following Foucault's piece in *The Order of Things*, write an essay on Velasquez's *Las Meninas*; as a visual commentary on picture making.

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- 2 (b) Write an essay on how Norman Bryson differs from E-H Gombrich in explaining the rise of realism in Western Art
- 3 (a) Write an essay on the art of the Baroque / Mannerist period by comparing at least one artist and one poet from among the following: Michelangelo, Leonardo da Vinci, Bernini, Shakespeare, John Donne.

- 3 (b) "The spiritual and the bodily figure equally powerfully in representations of the human through the Rennaissance." Elaborate with reference to at least one painter and one poet in your course.
- 4 (a) "Classical mythstare thoroughly refashioned in the work of Botticelli, Spenser, Raphael and Titian". Would you agree? Write a reasoned answer by focusing on Spenser and at least one of the painters listed above.

- 4 (b) Write an essay on the ways that the figure of Venus is demystified by at least one writer and one painter in your course.
- 5. (a) "Alexander Pope and Claude Lorrain both attempt to represent ideal landscapes but do so by drawing on the differing resources available to poetry and painting." Would you agree? Give a reasoned answer.

- 5 (b) "Turner's works are great painterly realizations of the notion of "the sublime" as it developed through the eighteenth and nineteenth centuries. Elaborate with reference to at least two of his paintings.
- 6 (a) The inner life towards which Dutch painters gesture in their portraits of women is realized more fully in a novel such as *Mansfield Park*. Elaborate

6 (b) "The urban aesthetic ,as it develops through the eighteenth and nineteenth centuries, is inseparable from the social contradictions of the city." Elaborate with reference to "Industry and Idleness" and *Great Expectations*.

6 (c) Write an essay on interiors, moving between the paintings and the literature that you have studied in this course.
